



# Uniform & Team Apparel Policy

## Exclusive Supplier

Surrey United Soccer Club (the “Club”) has entered into an exclusive preferred supplier agreement with Soccer Express for all Club equipment, uniform, and fanwear. This policy is applicable to all SUSC teams of any age group (U6-Adult). The Club’s Team Store is located online: [Club Team Store](#) and members can purchase their official Clubwear and additional kit components (extra socks, shorts, etc.) through this link. No other uniforms are to be worn by any Club team at any time.

## Official Club Colours & Logo

- The primary colours for SUSC are Red and Black.
- All outerwear/training gear (track suits, tops, pants, jackets, training shirts, shorts & socks) must follow the primary color combination.
- The Club’s official logo must be on all uniforms for all official match where a team is representing the Club.

## Uniform Sizing

Club uniform orders are made with the best information available at the time of ordering. There will be no exchanges of Club uniforms unless the item is two sizes too big or too small for the player.

## Uniform Embellishments

No additional logos, numbers, or names are permitted on any Club jersey (any age group). This includes last names on the back of any jersey.

## Alternate Clubwear and/or Use of Club Logo

- Any team wishing to purchase alternative team training shirts or other alternative team apparel not available on the [Club Team Store](#), intended to represent the Club in any activity, requires the written approval of the Club.
- Requests under this section must be sent in advance of purchase to your Age Group Coordinator for

review and decision by the Club.

## Team Sponsors and Sponsor Logo Use

- Teams may find team sponsors and donors to help cover the costs of team specific equipment, travel, and any other expense not covered by the Club.
- Teams must receive sponsorship pre-approval from the Club Sponsorship Committee to ensure no conflict with other Club sponsor. Please contact: [sponsorship@surreyunitedsoccer.com](mailto:sponsorship@surreyunitedsoccer.com)
- Teams maintain full responsibility of contract terms and fund transfers between themselves and any team sponsor. If there is any dispute or grievance it will be dealt with between these two parties without involvement of the Club.
- Teams may put sponsor logos on purchased equipment such as, training shirts, jackets, bags, etc. on the express understanding that pre-approval from the sponsorship committee must be obtained and the request must include a printing proof of any sponsor logo use before production.
- All apparel and equipment must be official Clubwear purchased from the [Club Team Store](#) unless otherwise approved.

## Uniform Return

- Youth and Mini player socks and shorts are provided for players to keep.
- Mini players (U10 and under) may keep their jerseys at the end of each season. U11-U18 players are to return their jerseys after each playing season.
- It is the team staff’s responsibility to return all team uniforms with a completed Team Uniform Return Form within two weeks of the end of the related playing season (Fall/Winter or Spring).

## Fines

Fines may be imposed, and/or field allocation and other Club privileges removed at the Club’s discretion where this Policy is breached. Club decisions related to fines or other sanctions under this policy are not appealable.
